9.	ONLINE PROGRAM BY PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING CELL "ANGER ICEBERG: ANALYZING EMOTIONS BENEATH ANGER	May 27	Govt. Degree College, Chenani under the Aegis of its NSS unit, PRAYATNA, Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav Cell and Psychological Counseling Cell, organized an online program on "Anger Iceberg: Analyzing Emotions Beneath Anger" on 27th & 28th May 2021.  The purpose of program was to find out the root causes of anger among the students of the College and find out the solution of their anger and counsel them. A set of questions was prepared and circulated through Google form link. The experts at the Psychological Counseling Cell identified the students (through their responses) who had acute anger problems and have started measures to counsel them through online mode.
10.	CAREER APTITUDE TEST	May 29	Govt. Degree College, Chenani under the aegis of Manodarpan Initiative of MHRD, Govt. of India, Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav and Career Counseling Cell organised an online test on Career Aptitude on 29 <sup>th</sup> May 2021 to help the students in narrowing down their job choices and choose a career path that is compatible with their interests, skills, values, and personality. The purpose of this online test was to help students understand how a variety of personal attributes (i.e., data values, preferences, motivations, aptitudes and

			skills) impact their potential success and satisfaction with different career options and work environments. A set of questions was prepared and circulated through Google form link. The experts in the Career Counseling Cell analyzed the responses and found that the Career in the sciences was moderately preferred by the students. Most of the students had no highly preferred occupation. Creativity was not associated with student's academic performance while the rest such as, general scholastic aptitude (science ability, reading comprehension, verbal ability and mathematical ability), technical-vocational ability (clerical skill and visual manipulative skill), non-verbal ability, logical reasoning ability, and entrepreneurial skill (planning and decision making, budgeting, marketing and forecasting) were positively correlated to student's performance. The study indicated that mathematical ability, verbal ability and logical reasoning ability were predictors of student's academic performance.
